## FARMERS MARKET

We organized two Farmer's Market in January and February at Monalisa Kalagram, Koregaon Park in collaboration with Monalisa Kalagram.

He presented as a youngest panelist to suggest inputs on breaking the barriers in millet productivity through sustainable intensification and multi cropping systems.


## TRAINING ON 'BARDHANYA' CROPPING SYSTEMS

One-day training program was conducted on our model 'Baradhanya - Climate resilient cropping systems for nutrition security' at Kasarwadi village, Dahiwadi Tehsil, District Satara.
This training was organized for the drought farmers by AFARM organization under promotion of 'Nutrition Mission Project'.
A total of 82 farmers were trained through this sessions on our climate resilient 'Baradhanya multi cropping model' for conservation and promotion of the native and nutritious food.

## FIRST AGROFORESTRY PLANTATION BY KHOJIS

We had 8 volunteers at AGRO RANGERS from 'The great Indian treasure hunt', one of Khoj 's flagship programs, for 3 weeks to learn about the agriculture sector and work towards creating a sustainable ecosystem that not only benefits the environment but also empowers the surrounding community.

Their work started with our first Agroforestry project which is especially important for the droughtaffected area and to create a sustainable future for the farmers.


AGRO RANGERS in the support of Nisarg Foundation hosted a 3-day Online Training program from 25 27th March 2023 On 'Youth in Regenerative Agriculture.'

About 20 participants from 9 different countries attended the workshop which included Students, Farmers, Social Entrepreneurs as well as Journalists to gain knowledge and skills about sustainable agriculture practices and how to create resilient food systems. The workshop equipped participants with a deeper understanding and practical tips \& strategies for how to create regenerative agriculture systems that benefit both the environment and the community.

Setting up a value chai for farmers to deliver nursery saplings, bio fertilizers and drip [ irrigation system. 5.Starting implementation of agroforestry at farmers location from June 2023.
